Overview of LINC Educare Services

Educare services are offered to enhance the early learning experiences of children age zero to three and to ensure that high quality care is available to all children through school age.

Educare connects children, families, and providers with existing community services: home visits, educational opportunities, and resources such as toys, books and childcare equipment for use in child care facilities.

Educare offers large and small group training seminars in neighborhoods throughout the metropolitan area. Child care providers can receive home visits that provide more intensive training and assistance in working toward State licensing requirements and national accreditation.

All training opportunities are consistent with State approved Core Competencies and are available at no cost to any provider.

Educare is a partnership of the Local Investment Commission (LINC) and the State of Missouri.

All Educare trainers are registered and listed on the Missouri Trainer Registry database operated by the OPEN Initiative.
